PET ADDENDUM

This document will serve as an addendum to the *Welcome Aboard Booklet* provided to the patron upon check-in. Pet is defined as “an animal kept for amusement or companionship”. Service animals are not considered pets but must be registered with the campground.

Free roaming cats and dogs pose a potential public health threat to personnel on Navy installations and pose a threat to wildlife including endangered species and migratory birds. Unleashed animals present a danger to the community vehicle traffic and more importantly, the safety of children and youth onboard the installation. It is the charge of the Commanding Officer to ensure public health and safety onboard NAS Key West (NASKWINST 10570.1B ANIMAL CONTROL AND PET OWNER RESPONSIBILITY).

Pet Restrictions

- Only two (2) domesticated pets are allowed in each site. Exotic pets are not permitted.
- Recreation Lodging Campground management has the right to restrict pets due to display of aggressive and/or dangerous behavior. Restricted breeds include Akita, American Bull Dog, Chow, Doberman, ANY Pit Bull breed, and Rottweiler.
- It is the moral and legal responsibility of each pet owner to remove any solid excrement produced by his/her animal. Owners should take care that animals do not relieve themselves on the property of others or ensure all solid excrement is appropriately disposed of.
- Annual vaccinations required. For dogs, this includes rabies, distemper, parvovirus, leptospirosis and bordatella vaccines; for cats this includes rabies, upper respiratory (FVRCP), and if the cat is outdoors, feline leukemia (FLVE).

- All cats and dogs shall wear, while outside the home or temporarily lodging of the resident, a collar tag. NAS Key West Security shall contact local authorities for non-compliance, and cooperate with law enforcement requests. Animals found without proper identification are subject to confiscation.
- No owner shall permit dog or cat to leave the owners premises unless such animal is under direct control of the owner and is wearing a leash of sufficient strength to restrain the particular animal, and is under the positive control of a person of a suitable age and discretion. Positive control does not include verbal command or control, regardless of the animals demonstrated abilities of training.

Service Animals

NAS Key Wet defines a “service animal” as a dog that has been individually trained to do work or perform tasks for an individual with a disability or handicap. The task(s) performed by the dog must be directly related to the person’s disability. Such dogs are permitted inside non-classified government building/facilities to assist owners aiding the disability. Service animals are to be properly marked with collar, vest or other conspicuous marking and must remain in the positive control of the owner at all time, absent a medical emergency.

“Emotional Support” animals may qualify as a “service animal” where the dog is both required because of a documented disability and has been trained to perform a task related to that specific disability.
